



Lady Bay Primary School Plan for Remote Education – September 2021

Where a pupil is unable to attend school because they are isolating due to a positive test, we will offer access to remote education. This will be shared using the link to **google drive** which is on the **class pages** of the school website.

The DFE have released new guidance which states that children who are isolating after positive test and who are well enough to access learning, should continue access to high quality learning at home. The DFE have endorsed the material on the Oak Academy and have recommended that schools direct their children and parents to these online lessons. The content of the lessons will support the learning objectives for your child's year group.

Although your child will be isolating at home, staff will continue to be teaching the other 29 children and therefore will not be able to offer the same feedback as they were able to during the last lockdown. Staff will of course be happy to look at the work completed when your child returns to school if they would like to share it.

Material can be accessed on the google drive through the class pages. Hyperlinks will be provided on a word document which will take you to the work your children can do at home for the days that they will not be in school.

For our new children that may not be familiar with google drive, additional information will be given by the class teachers.
