

New Intake Parents' meeting June 2022

- Introduction

We aim to create a welcoming, stimulating and active learning environment which will encourage children to explore, investigate and learn through first-hand experiences. We ensure the children feel secure and confident, and are challenged to develop their independence through all areas of the curriculum.

Activities are planned for inside and outside and the children have the freedom to move between the inside and outside classroom at various points throughout the day. The indoor learning environment is divided into a variety of different learning areas to meet the expectations of the curriculum: e.g. reading tent; construction area, role play (home corner) maths area, literacy area, creative table etc. Children are encouraged to become independent learners and take some responsibility for their own lines of enquiry and investigation.

- Structure of the unit- free flow, play based learning, mix of adult and child led activities, set carpet areas for register/ dismissal/ some taught carpet activities. We'll go into more detail of the curriculum in September and dates for phonics/reading/writing meetings in Autumn Term.
- Readiness for school- independent toileting/ wiping, use cutlery, recognise their name, begin to write their name, capital letter and the rest lowercase, interested in stories, able to follow simple instruction/rules, beginning to count.
- Label ALL items of clothing- PE kits/ uniform/ socks/ coats/hats/ gloves shoes! Children to come to school in their PE kits- day TBC in September
- All about me document- please send to the office ASAP! It is always a great insight with getting to know your child and helps us build a relationship with them.
